Our Labor/Delivery/Recovery/Postpartum suites provide a home-like environment during your labor, with fully adjustable birthing beds, a comfortable chair for Mommy or visitor and a private bathroom with shower. Your room also comes with internet, television and telephone.

During labor and delivery, dedicated obstetrical anesthesia services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You will remain in your LDRP suite during the entire labor and delivery process as a nurse closely monitors your labor. A support person may remain with you throughout the whole birthing experience. After delivery, the staff will ensure that both mother and baby are doing well and provide plenty of time for you to breastfeed and bond with your baby for the first time, should you choose to do so.

GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER.

Our mother/baby rooms are furnished with a television, telephone and fold out bed or reclining chair for Dad or guest. Our state-of-the-art security system is designed to protect your baby night and day.

SHARING YOUR JOY.

A new baby is big news, a bundle of joy to share with family and friends. During your labor and delivery, our campuses offer a family/visitor waiting room for the comfort of your expectant guests. Once you're settled, visitors are encouraged to visit between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. Dad (or the primary support person) is welcome to visit any time as well as stay overnight, and Baby's brothers and sisters may visit in your room during day or evening hours.

Pediatrics



For your peace of mind, our Pediatric Department includes six pediatric emergency beds, eight pediatric inpatient beds and a six-bed Pediatric Intensive Care Unit.

Our Pediatric ICU offers all private rooms with state-of-the-art monitoring equipment and specialized treatment for respiratory, endocrinology, neurosurgery, oncology, orthopedics, sepsis and RSV cases. Our interdisciplinary staff includes physicians, Pediatric Intensivists, nurses, a Child Life Specialist, chaplains, social workers, nutrition therapists, volunteers and other trained healthcare members uniquely qualified to care for infants, children, adolescents and their families. Pediatric surgical services range from intracranial to cancer treatment. Family-centered care means 24-hour-a-day, 7-day-a-week visitation and parents can even sleep at their child's bedside. Our state-of-the-art security system is designed to protect your child day and night.
