Description:	In 1947, the Adrian Dominican Sisters of Adrian, Michigan, purchased Basic Magnesium Hospital in Henderson, Nevada, from the U.S. government. Today, St. Rose Dominican Hospitals is the only not-for-profit, religiously sponsored hospital system in southern Nevada and consists of three campuses – Rose de Lima, Siena and San Martín.
